

## *Ancestors of George Elof Swanson*

### *Generation No. 1*

**1. George Elof Swanson**, born 22 Oct 1894 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York; died 25 Jun 1979 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. He was the son of **2. Anders Gustaf Svensson** and **3. Josefina Johansdotter**. He married **(1) Laurina Evangeline Mabel Nystrand** 30 Jun 1919 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. She was born 15 Jun 1895 in Ludlow, Pennsylvania, and died 08 Mar 1985 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. She was the daughter of Jan Petter Jansson Nystrand and Hilma Maria Lovisa Anderson.

Notes for George Elof Swanson:

World War I draft registration shows him as living at 11 Morton Street, Jamestown, NY, born 22 Oct 1894 in Jamestown, by occupation a tool maker. He was single and registered as a conscientious objector.

Notes for Laurina Evangeline Mabel Nystrand:

Baptized 14 March 1897, Moriah Lutheran Church, Ludlow, PA.

### *Generation No. 2*

**2. Anders Gustaf Svensson**, born 21 May 1847 in Hästhagen, Strängsered Parish, Älvsborgs län, Sweden; died 16 Feb 1941 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. He was the son of **4. Sven Johansson** and **5. Maja Greta Abrahamsdotter**. He married **3. Josefina Johansdotter** 08 Jan 1871 in Hössna Parish, Älvsborgs län, Sweden.

**3. Josefina Johansdotter**, born 10 May 1851 in Silleberg, Hössna Parish, Älvsborgs län, Sweden; died 14 Jul 1916 in Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. She was the daughter of **6. Johannes Jonasson** and **7. Maria Danielsdotter**.

Notes for Anders Gustaf Svensson:

He was born at the croft at Hästhagen, Strängsered Parish. In 1865 he was living at Tissered Lillgården and, in the same year, moved to Hössna. In 1871 he lived at Gullerud, in 1876 he was living in Liared and in 1878-81 he was living in Hössna. Swedish records show he emigrated to America from Sjoryd, Hössna on 30 September 1881.

Family tradition says on the voyage across the Atlantic they were 3 days out from England and had to turn back for repairs because the boat was leaking badly.

1900 Federal Census shows him residing with his family at 11 Morton Street, Jamestown, NY. His occupation is shown as "engineer." According to George E. Swanson (b. 1921 d. 2007) Anders Gustaf's children George and Ethel were born there. The house was sold around 1924 and Gust moved to the corner of Swanson and Chambers Streets. He lived with his son George from about 1934 until his death in 1960. Born at the croft (torp) Hästhagen in Strängsered parish. In 1865 was living at Tissered Lillgården and, in the same year, moved to Hössna parish. In 1871, lived in Gullered parish, in 1876 in Liared and in 1876-1881 in Hössna.

1910 Federal Census shows him residing at 11 Morton Street, Jamestown, NY. His occupation was metal worker at a metal factory. Record says he immigrated in 1880. Children listed (all b. NY), Lillian (age 20), Telmer (age 18), George (age 15) and Ethel (age 12). Also in household was Carl Olson, age 18, born NY, nephew.

1920 Federal Census shows him residing at #11(no street listed but likely Morton Street), Jamestown, NY. He was age 73, a metal worker. Also listed was Ethel Swanson, who would have been his daughter (record incorrectly lists her as his wife). She was age 23.

According to George (b. 1921 d. 2007) "It is said he never saw a doctor or a dentist, and he grew two small front teeth after he was 90. On the day of his death, probably of pneumonia, he was taken to the home of his

daughter Ella where he died shortly after entering the house. He always seemed to be in good health. He chewed Mail Pouch tobacco, which might have helped any toothaches. He loved gardening and grew hundreds of pink gladiolas as well as loads of vegetables on Chambers Street. He said his father's name was Sven Johansson, who played the violin."

Gust. Swanson became a naturalized US citizen on 25 October 1890 in Jamestown, NY.

Records of Lake View Cemetery Association show:

Gustaf A. Swanson died at 21 Chadakoin Street, Celoron, his residence at time of death. He died 16 February 1941, age 93 years, 9 months, 24 days, was a widower who was born in Sweden and died of a coronary embolism. His father was Sven Swanson (actually, this record is incorrect, should be Sven Johansson), he was a retired metal worker. The funeral was held 2:30pm on 18 February 1941, E.J. Youngberg, undertaker. His physician was Dt. Wetzen.

His obituary says he he was the oldest charter member of Lutheran Immanuel Church and died suddenly at 6pm at the home of his daughter Mrs. Carl A. Johnson at Celoron. It also says he had been living with his son, George Swanson, on Garfield Road, death occurring during a visit to his daughter. The obituary also says he had been a metal worker at the Art Metal Construction Company.

Volume 1 of the records of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Jamestown, list the family of Anders Gustaf Svenson and Mrs. Josefina Svenson as charter members. All of their children except Hilma are listed - who was probably not living with the family and did not become a charter member.

Notes for Josefina Johansdotter:

Records of Lake View Cemetery Association show Josephine Swanson died at 11 Morton Street, July 14, 1916 at age 65 years, 2 months, 4 days. She was married, born in Sweden and her residence at time of death was 11 Morton Street. Cause of death was "impact of lung" and the funeral was 16 July 1916. She was listed as a housewife, interred "in lot of George E. Swanson" and her parents were listed as "Johnson."

1900 census shows family at 116 Hall Avenue, Jamestown, Chautauqua County, NY. Record says he immigrated in 1889 and she immigrated in 1882. He was superintendant for Art Metal. The record also says they had been married 9 years and she had 5 children, 3 of whom were still alive in 1900.

1910 census shows family on Orchard Avenue, Jamestown, Chautauqua County, NY. Record also says he immigrated in 1887 and was a superintendant at a metal factory.

1920 census shows family at 102 Hall Avenue, Jamestown, Chautauqua County, NY. He was superintendant of a metal factory. Children were Oliver (age 25), Irene (age 22) and Julius (age 18).

1930 census shows family at 102 Hall Avenue, Jamestown, Chautauqua County, NY. He worked at a metal plant. Children Albert (age 35), Irene (age 33) and Julius (age 28) were in household. Record shows he immigrated in 1887 and she immigrated in 1881.

World War I draft registration, Chautauqua County, NY, shows him as Oscar S. Swanson, living at 30 Orchard Ave, Jamestown. His birthdate was shown as 25 July 1880 and he was superintendant at Art Metal Construction. He was married, wife was Vernie Swanson.

Notes for Maria Edalia Swanson:

According to the records of First Lutheran Church, Jamestown, NY, she was born in Jamestown 8 June 1883, baptized in 1883, confirmed 21 May 1899 and received into membership 22 April 1928. She married Carl August Oscar Johnson 11 February 1904 and died 8 September 1960 with the funeral being 10 September 1960. She was buried in Lake View Cemetery, age 77 years, 3 months, no days and her residence was listed as 21 Chadakoin Street, Celoron.

Shown in 1900 census as born June 1883, single, occupation "cottonweaver" living with her parents.

According to George E. Swanson (b. 1921 d. 2007) she was the first child of Anders Gustaf and Josefina who was born in America.

Lake View Cemetery Association records show she died at W.C.A. Hospital of "general carcinamatois." Her funeral was 10 September 1960 at 3pm. Undertakers: Henderson & Lincoln.

Notes for Carl August Oscar Johnson:

Records of First Lutheran Church, Jamestown, NY show he was born in Sweden 19 December 1878, baptized 1878, confirmed 1893, received into membership 22 April 1928. He died 24 August 1961 and was buried at Lake View Cemetery 26 August 1961. Church records show the family of Carl A.O. Johnson lived at 26 McDaniel and at 21 Chadakoin Streets, Celoron.

Lake View Cemetery Association records show he died at W.C.A. Hospital on 24 August 1961, age 82 years, 8 months, 5 days, was a widower, born in Sweden on 19 December 1878 and he died of "acute myocardial infarction." He resided at 21 East Chadakoin Street, Celoron, his parents are listed as August and Louisa Johnson and he was a "retired chief engineer at a metal manufacturing co." His funeral was 3pm August 26, 1961. Undertakers: Henderson & Lincoln. Relative named in the record:

Tenant farmer at Bregardet, a torp (tenant farm) belonging to the farm Herregarden in Hössna Parish. The family moved back and forth between the tenant farms Skrevet, Bredala and Bregardet and also lived on the tenant farm Raken, belonging to the farm Valared, for some years.

Listed in the death records as having died of "blood spitting" (possibly TB?)

More About Daniel Svensson:

Burial: 30 Apr 1820

Notes for Catharina Larsdotter:

Catharina and her children moved to the tenant farm Rya, to Valared in 1824 and in 1825 to a cottage belonging to Holmarp Overgarden in Hössna. She died at the cottage in Holmarp and was buried 10 March 1844. She died of "a cold."

More About Catharina Larsdotter:

Burial: 10 Mar 1844
