BEMUS POINT — Antone V. Johnson, 76, of 7 Sunnyside Ave., a veteran of World War I, died at 6 a.m. today (Aug. 5, 1966) in Jamestown General Hospital.

Mr. Johnson operated a grocery store here for 25 years and prior to his retirement was employed by the Jamestown Electro-Plating, Inc.

He was born Oct. 3, 1889, in Jamestown, the son of Andrew and Wilhelmina Johnson.

Mr. Johnson served with the 47th Aero Squadron, with service overseas from March 1918 to July 1919.

He was a member of the Bemus Point Methodist Church; was an exempt member of the Bemus Point Fire Dept.; and a member of Ellery Memorial Post, American Legion.

Surviving are a son, A. Herman Johnson; and two grandchildren, Valarie and William Richard Johnson, all of Bemus Point; and one sister, Mrs. Lisle Beers, Haddonfield, N.J.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Evans Funeral Home. The Rev. Bruce Hankey, pastor of the Buffalo Street Methodist Church, Jamestown, will officiate. Burial will be in Bemus Point Cemetery.
